

RANGER TEAM LEADER INITIATIVE (RTLI)

The Warrior Training Center's Ranger Team Leader Initiative (RTLI) is the Army National Guard's premier and centralized training program for enlisted Soldiers who want to attend Ranger School. RTLI provides Soldiers from OSUT with advanced instruction on land navigation, Ranger Physical Assessments (RPA), Combat Water Survival Training (CWST), Ranger Technical Tasks (RTTs, and all core events needed to pass Ranger School.

MISSION SET:

- Graded Ranger Physical Assessments (RPAs).
- 3 Land Navigation Courses & Instruction.
- Ranger Technical Tasks Training.
- Combat Water Survival Training.
- Ranger Packing List Preparation.
- Foot march preparation.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be Army National Guard.
- Must volunteer to attend Ranger School.
- Must accept a 4-month extension of orders.
- Physical standards: 49 push ups, 59 sit-ups, and a 2-mile run time below 15:00.
- An APFT will be used as a diagnostic.
- No restriction on citizenship or GT score.

- Opportunity to walk on to Airborne School after passing Ranger School.
- Other post Ranger School training depends on WTC training schedule.
- 4-month extension of active pay.

INFORMATION FOR OSUT:

- RTLI candidates must be scheduled for an Airborne/Ranger physical.
- No contract required. Volunteering for RTLI initiates our orders process with SM's state. SMs will receive DD214 and then begin on state orders after graduation.
- The WTC manages SM transportation.
