They are warriors who are trained, equipped and integrated to attack, defeat and exploit unexploded ordnance, improvised explosive devices and weapons of mass destruction.

MISSION - To provide support to unified land operations by detecting, locating, identifying, diagnosing, rendering safe, exploiting, and disposing of all explosive ordnance, improvised explosive devices, improvised/homemade explosives, and weapons of mass destruction.

- PHASE I Fort Gregg-Adams 7 weeks (Preparation Course)
- ▶ PHASE II Eglin Air Force Base 26 weeks (Intensified Course)

- Research and identify ordnance
- Assist in the preparation and use of advanced robotics
- Render Safe and/or dispose of hazardous devices, materials or ordnance
- Prepare and maintain tools, equipment and vehicles
